ALL THESE COLLECTIONS ARE FREE TO ACCESS. WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE FAMILYSEARCH COLLECTION, THE TEXT HAS BEEN MADE SEARCHABLE USING OPTICAL CHARACTER RECOGNITION (OCR), THOUGH THE QUALITY OF THIS VARIES.

THERE HAVE BEEN OTHER ONLINE COLLECTIONS OF THE JOURNALS IN THE PAST AND THIS DIRECTORY WILL BE UPDATED IF THEY ARE REINSTATED OR NEW COLLECTIONS BECOME AVAILABLE.

SECTIONS OF THE JOURNALS

COLLECTIONS OF THE JOURNALS ARE NOT IDENTICAL! IN ADDITION TO MANY COLLECTIONS BEING INCOMPLETE, THE SEQUENCE OF PAGES AND SECTIONS CAN VARY FROM ONE COLLECTION TO ANOTHER. GENERALLY, ALL THE ISSUES IN A VOLUME WERE HARDBOUND TOGETHER BUT THE SECTIONS WERE OFTEN REARRANGED BEFOREHAND, AND EACH SUBSCRIBER TOOK THEIR OWN APPROACH TO THIS. IT IS, THEREFORE, EASIER TO NAVIGATE THE JOURNALS IF YOU UNDERSTAND THE DIFFERENT SECTIONS AND THEIR RESPECTIVE PAGE NUMBERING SYSTEMS.

Section	Page numbering	Description
Preface	In the first volume, Arabic numerals continuing from the main content. After that, Roman numerals (e.g. i, ii, iii), restarting in each new issue.	Included frontispiece illustrations, cover pages, introductory remarks, lists of subscribers (a.k.a. members), accounts, treasurer's reports, contents pages and lists of illustrations. After Volume I, the page numbering restarted in each issue so the same page number can recur several times in a volume. For example, Volume XII comprised six issues, each with its own preface, and an overall table of contents, thus this volume has seven different pages numbered v, vi, etc.
Main content	Arabic numerals (e.g. 1, 2, 3), continuing across issues and restarting in each new volume.	Predominantly "Reports from Counties" with entries presented under parish/graveyard headings that were arranged alphabetically within each county. Later issues included Notes and Queries, Book Notices, Miscellanea, will transcripts, overseas gravestones and birth/marriage/death notices from <i>The Dublin Journal</i> . Full-page illustrations and extra-wide pages (e.g. for pedigree charts) were printed separately, to be interleaved; these were labelled "to face page #".
Funeral entries	Arabic numerals in square brackets (e.g. [1], [2], [3]), continuing across issues and volumes.	Transcripts of funeral entries were published in Volumes VII and VIII. Drawings of the coats of arms in these funeral entries were published in Volumes X, XI and XII. Funeral entry sections had their own indexes.
Parish registers	Arabic numerals with asterisks (e.g. 1*, 2*, 3*), continuing across issues and volumes.	Transcripts of complete collections of parish registers were published in Volumes XI, XII and XIII. Most were from Co. Dublin but there were a few from other localities. Parish register sections had their own indexes.
Main indexes	In volumes I-V, Roman numerals. In volumes VI-X, Arabic numerals continuing from the main content. After that, Arabic numerals starting at 1.	In early volumes, indexes of the main content included both personal names and placenames; these were separated in later volumes. Indexes were in dictionary order in some volumes and just arranged by first letter in other volumes. They may be absent from some collections because, from Volume III, indexes were charged for separately and it is possible that not every subscriber purchased them.

Note: Addenda et Corrigenda appeared in different places in different volumes.
